There were no comments made from the public regarding the agenda items.

Motion was made by Bryan Vidrine and seconded by Ryan Ardoin approving the June 3, 2019 Committee and Regular Meeting Minutes. Motion carried.

Presentation of Annual Audit report will be tabled until the next regular meeting.

Motion was made by Lamar Johnson and seconded by Bryan Vidrine approving to proceed with the rolling forward of the 2019 tax millages. Motion carried.

Public Works Director, Chester Granger, gave the following report:

- 2% Drainage Equipment is working in District 4 for repairs to a bridge.
- Ward 1 Drainage Equipment is in District 7. Work should be completed in the next few days then moving on to District 1.
- Requesting the jury to perform work inside the Town of Basile to assist with drainage work.

Motion was made by Rocky Rider and seconded by Lamar Johnson approving Public Works Director to assist with drainage work inside the Town of Basile. Motion carried.

- Chip Seal Project has begun and currently working in District 2 then moving on to a project in the Town of Mamou.
- Requesting the approval for the purchase of two railcars for District 5.

Motion was made by Kevin Veillon and seconded by Ryan Ardoin to approve the purchase of two railcars for District 5. Motion carried.

- Requesting to hire three additional workers for the chip seal crew at \$11.00/hour and also the hiring of Bob Reed, part-time at \$10.00/hour for Region B.

Motion was made by Rocky Rider and seconded by Lamar Johnson to approve the hiring of three workers for the chip seal project at \$11.00/hour, effective immediately. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Ryan Ardoin and seconded by Kevin Veillon to approve the hiring of Bobby Reed, part-time at \$10.00 per hour, effective immediately. Motion carried.

- Approval to change employee status for Monica Mahaffey from part-time to full-time with a \$.50/hr. pay increase.

Motion was made by Bryan Vidrine and seconded by Sidney Fontenot to approve the status change for District 7 employee, Monica Mahaffey from part-time to full-time with a \$.50/hour pay increase. Motion carried.

Secretary-Treasurer, Donald Bergeron, gave the following report:

- Acadian Ambulance report is in compliance with the ordinance.
- Letter was received from Private Investigation Agency commending Cynthia Montes, Janitor at the Courthouse, for aiding a visitor to the courthouse during a heavy rain storm.
- 2% Sales Tax collection for the month of May collected in June, \$287,190.19.
- Mr. Bergeron stated that each juror has been e-mailed copies of the Parish budget to actual comparison report for each fund and asked the Jury if they had any questions regarding those reports. No comments were reported.
