Discussion was held on the parcel appraisal of Ward 1 Industrial Park property. The property valuation received as inspected by appraiser is approximately 64,010 sq. ft. which is approximately 1.47 acres at \$25,000.00/acre. Appraisal for property at Ward 1 Industrial Park totaled \$36,750.00.

Health care proposals for the fiscal year 2020-2021 were reviewed and discussed. The current renewal premium with United Healthcare has a 21.7% increase. Two other quotes from Blue Cross Blue Shield were discussed which will give the employees an option to choose the plan which best fits their needs.

A policy change to per diem meals was then discussed. The Parish policy needs to be changed to coincide with per diem rates on US General Services Administration website.

The 2020 Census is approaching and over the next decade lawmakers, business owners and many others will use this 2020 census data to make critical decisions. Actions will need to be taken to ensure accurate count.

It was stated that during the month of February 2020 76 permits were issued.
