LUS Fiber Representative, Ryan Meche, addressed the Jury on providing high speed fiber to homes throughout the Parish. Grant applications are being worked on for state and federal funding.

Proposed Administrative Code Section 101, regarding building permitting and inspections was then discussed. Article 101 will enable Rapides Area Planning Commission the ability to enforce action on those who do not comply with building codes.

Water meters for cemeteries served by Turkey Creek Water System were then discussed. The Jury is requesting Turkey Creek for a flat rate per year rather than a residential rate.

Motion was made by Lamar Johnson and seconded by Bryan Vidrine to rescind resolution adopted on July 12, 2021 moving polling location (04/4040) from Berl Clark Store to Lake Cove Baptist Church. Precinct 04/4040 voting location will remain at the Berl Clark Store located at 1059 Lake Cove Road, Ville Platte, La. Motion carried.

Sample road use permit has been reviewed by legal and minor changes were made. Before adoption of the permit ordinance, it will be reviewed by the parish and brought back before the full jury for discussion and approval.

Motion was made by Eric Soileau and seconded by Ryan Ardoin approving to move the remaining committee agenda items to the regular meeting agenda due to time limit. Motion carried.
