Process for issuing temporary permits was then discussed. Currently the parish issues temporary permits that technically expire in 180 days. Adopting a policy will spell out the process for renewal. Motion was made by Sidney Fontenot and seconded by Eric Soileau approving to approach Avoyelles Parish with obtaining more information regarding their permit policy and also having the Inspecting Firm for Evangeline Parish's input. Motion carried.

An analysis was done on the Parish's loss revenue due to COVID last year. Federal Funds from the American Rescue Plan Act have been received and guidelines state that those funds can be used for Parish loss of revenues of all funds. Motion was made by Sidney Fontenot and seconded by Bryan Vidrine approving to move \$1,161,303 out of the American Rescue Act Fund and into General Fund to ensure obligations are met for the remaining of the year. Motion carried.

COVID -19 Policies was then discussed. The parish has been following the policy of extended sick days for COVID infections/exposure for employees. It was questioned, moving forward, would the Jury like to continue that policy or change it. Juror, Sidney Fontenot stated that the Police Jury is an arm of the legislative branch of government and is recommending contacting the legislative government on what their guidelines are and comparing that to the parish's policy and move forward. In the meantime the parish will use the policy in place at this time.

Motion was made by Eric Soileau and seconded by Sidney Fontenot approving to adjourn the Executive Committee Meeting. Motion carried.
