Preliminary Reapportionment Plan requirements

As advertised a public hearing was held on Monday, September 13, 2021 at 3:30 p.m. in the Police Jury Meeting room of the Courthouse Building, 200 Court Street, Ste. 207, Ville Platte, La for the purpose of hearing comments and/or questions on the Preliminary Reapportionment Plan requirements.

Chief Demographer, Mike Hefner, addressed the Jury stating that law requires, after each census is taken, any entity that works by representative by district will have to examine the apportionment plan of its body to determine if there exists any substantial variation in the representation of the election districts. Reapportionment is a matter of changing the district boundaries to ensure equal populations between districts. Mr. Hefner went over reapportionment plans with the Jury.

Being there were no further comments or questions the hearing was declared closed.
