A request was received from Evangeline Parish Animal Rescue (EPAR) for the parish to assist with the cost of dirt work on property the parish purchased for an animal shelter. EPAR hired a contractor to bring in 700 yards of dirt and build a 30ft x 140 ft pad in order to build an animal shelter. In conversation almost 2 years ago it was said the Jury might pay for dirt work. Motion was made by Bryan Vidrine and seconded by Ryan Ardoin approving to pay for the dirt work as requested by EPAR in the amount of \$6,200.00. Motion carried.

Secretary-Treasurer, Donald Bergeron, stated to the Jury the permit clerk has not received a raise since hired and is now taking on issuing flood zone certificates in addition to building permits. Public works secretary will be taking on paperwork for sewer department. Motion was made by Sidney Fontenot and seconded by Eric Soileau approving a \$1.50/hr. raise for Permit Clerk, Candice Dominique, approving a \$1.00/hr. raise for Public Works Secretary, Sarah Sittig and approving a \$.75/hr. raise for Accounts Payable Secretary, Rachel West due to additional job duties. Motion carried.

The current mosquito sprayer has been repaired and chemicals were purchased to spray populated areas of the parish. A second sprayer is available to purchase in order to cover more area quicker, if the Jury would wish. The estimated cost is \$10,000. Motion was made by Ryan Ardoin and seconded by Keith Saucier approving the purchase of two mosquito spraying units to be paid out of the health unit fund. Motion carried.

Demographer, Mike Hefner addressed the Jury to discuss reapportionment. Mr. Heffner presented two plans for the jurors to review. The Jury has until June of 2023 to adopt a plan.

Motion was made by Eric Soileau and seconded Sidney Fontenot approving to adjourn the Executive Committee Meeting. Motion carried.
