

The Police Jury met in regular session assembled with the following members present: Bryan Vidrine, Sidney Fontenot, Kevin Veillon, Ryan Williams, Lelia Thrasher, Eric Soileau, Keith Saucier, and Daniel Arvie. Absent and excused was Ryan Ardoin. A quorum was present.

There were no comments on the agenda from the public.

Motion was made by Ryan Williams and seconded by Keith Saucier approving the February 7, 2022 Committee and Regular Meeting Minutes. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Ryan Williams and seconded by Eric Soileau approving the adoption of a resolution approving the holding of an election in Evangeline Parish Communications District, Louisiana, on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, to authorize the continuation of a special tax therein. Motion carried.

Appointment for the Ward Four Water District Board will be tabled until next meeting.

Appointment to represent Hospital and Industry on PMAC Committee will be tabled until next meeting.

Motion was made by Ryan Williams and seconded by Keith Saucier approving Joseph Wayne McMillan to replace Todd Welch to Evangeline Parish Water District No. 1. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Sidney Fontenot and seconded by Ryan Williams to approve the jail supply list as submitted. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Daniel Arvie, seconded by Sidney Fontenot and unanimously approved to amend the agenda to add the following items:

1. Discuss Sewer Committee agenda item-Update on sewer and water system upgrades.
2. Wayne Vidrine to discuss trailer parks.

Wayne Vidrine addressed the Jury to receive clarification on the application process to obtain a permit for a mobile home/travel trailer park, in order to accommodate workers for the Cabot project. The Jury clarified and explained the ordinance verbiage to Mr. Vidrine. Mr. Vidrine is requesting from the Jury to waive the 6 month permit renewal and have a contract signed instead. Motion was made by Ryan Williams and seconded by to have the Jury's legal advisors' approval before a contract is made with Mr. Vidrine's trailer park. Motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding sewer and water system upgrades. There are two compliance orders, one in the Industrial Park and another in Wyble Subdivision. Motion was made by Ryan Williams and seconded by Keith Saucier approving to request for extension of work for water and sewer system upgrades. Motion carried.

Public Works Director gave the following report:

- Request the hiring of a truck driver for Region B

Motion was made by Sidney Fontenot and seconded by Kevin Veillon to approve the hiring of Jeremy Borque as truck driver for Region B at \$15.69 per hour, retroactive to February 16, 2022. Motion carried.

- Request transfer of employees.

Motion was made by Sidney Fontenot and seconded by Keith Saucier approving the transfer of employee, Blaze Bergeron from the Ville Platte Yard for District #1 to the Mamou Yard at \$13.50/hr. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Keith Saucier and seconded by Sidney Fontenot to approve the transfer of employee, Greg Manuel from District #5 & #7 to District #1 at \$13/hour. Motion carried.

- Parish Wide Drainage is located in District #6 then will moving to District#4.
- Ward One Drainage equipment is being used in District #5.
- An auction will be held April 9, 2022 for all excess parish equipment next month.

Motion was made by Sidney Fontenot and seconded by Lelia Thrasher authorizing the payment of bills on file in the office. Motion carried.

No reports were given from Parish Engineer at this time.

Secretary-Treasurer, Donald Bergeron, gave the following report:

- Acadian Ambulance monthly report is in compliance with the ordinance.
- Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with EPAR has been finalized. Contributions made in the amount of \$1,000/month will be split, with a portion of \$655 towards the payment of the animal control building and \$345 towards the payment of veterinary bills.
- Mr. Bergeron stated that each juror has been emailed the parish budget to actual comparison reports for each fund and asked the Jury if there were any questions regarding those reports. No comments were reported.
- 2% Sales Use Tax collected in the month of February 2022 for January 2022, \$330,436.64.

Motion was made by Kevin Veillon and seconded by Keith Saucier approving to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
