SECTION 6.1: HEALTH INSURANCE

The Evangeline Parish Police Jury's health insurance plan provides employees and their dependents access to medical benefits. Regular full-time employees, working a minimum of 30 hours per week are eligible to participate in the health insurance plan, along with their legal spouse and dependents. For employee's age 65 and older and otherwise interested, the jury will provide access to an independent expert resource to assist them in understanding Medicare coverage, cost and regulations.
