Temporary Permit Ordinance

As advertised a public hearing was held on Monday July 11, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. in the Police Jury Meeting Room of the Courthouse Building, 200 Court Street, Ste. 207, Ville Platte, La to hear comments from the public regarding the adoption of a temporary permit ordinance.

Concerns from the Jury are if giving a 200 amp temporary service to residents; this can be turned into a home service without being properly permitted for the home.

Mr. Rick Harper, Parish Building Inspector, addressed the Jury with recommendations on creating a permit ordinance. Mr. Harper stated that it's a burden to the public that are trying to do right because of some people trying to take advantage of the situation. In the past, people have been building without permits and creating a temporary permit ordinance will help alleviate what a temporary pole is and what is allowed.
