There were no comments made from the public regarding the agenda items.

Motion was made by Ryan Ardoin and seconded by Kevin Veillon to approve the June 6, 2022 Public Hearing, Committee and Regular Meeting Minutes. Motion carried.

A public hearing was held last month on the removal of a three way stop sign on Shuff Road. There was no public comments were made at that hearing. No action will be taken, three way stop sign will remain.

Secretary-Treasurer, Donald Bergeron, gave the following report:

- Received notice from the inspector on updates needed at the Ville Platte Health Unit Building and is requesting from the Jury to get a contractor to address the issues.

Motion was made by Ryan Williams and seconded by Lelia Thrasher to approve the hiring of a contractor to address issued at the Ville Platte Health Unit Building. Motion carried.

- Several adjudicated properties in the parish are over 36 months and have interested buyers. Requesting from the Jury to advertise to accept bids for the sale of adjudicated properties.
- Acadian Ambulance report is in compliance with the ordinance.
- Mr. Bergeron stated that each juror has been emailed the parish budget to actual comparison reports for each fund and asked the Jury if there were any questions regarding those reports. No comments were reported.
- 2% Sales Use Tax for May collected in June, \$336,288.29.
