Nuisance Ordinance was then discussed. Issues throughout the Parish where residential yards are accumulating with trash, which is an eye sore and can decrease the value of the adjacent properties. Current Nuisance Ordinance states the following:

Section 16-95.-Violations; penalty for disregarding notices or orders.

- (a) The owner of any property where a nuisance is found to exist and who shall fail to comply with any notice to abate served pursuant to the chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not exceeding \$200.00 for each offense and a further sum of \$20.00 for each and every day such failure to comply continues beyond the date fixed for compliance.

Secretary-Treasurer and President of the Police Jury will contact the Sheriff in scheduling a meeting to see if his office can assist with those violating the nuisance ordinance.

Rental Fee - \$50 per day

Guidelines- no vendor is allowed to duplicate the same food items. Smoke or odors must not be offensive to other vendors. Vendors must keep areas clean. All trash is to be disposed of and placed in dumpster located by exit gate. Vendors using electrical outlets must not overload circuits. Anyone causing an overload will be disconnected.

Responsibility- It is the responsibility of the vendor to provide proof of required licenses, peddler or occupational. Also must provide Department of Health certificate.
