CROOKED CREEK COMMITTEE

The Crooked Creek Committee met with the following members present: Lelia Thrasher, Daniel Arvie, Eric Soileau and Bryan Vidrine. Absent and excused was Ryan Ardoin. A quorum was present.

The Committee then discussed EPA wanting to do a study on methane gas from decaying vegetation. EPA has chosen Crooked Creek Recreational Park along with other sites to do a short term study. This will take about 24 hours to perform. Motion was made Bryan Vidrine and seconded by Daniel Arvie approving Secretary-Treasurer to gather more information from EPA before allowing the study. Motion carried.

An update was given by Park Manager, Kim Ortego. Mr. Ortego stated that the Fourth of July was a success with 150 campers, and 480 visitors.

Also, information was obtained from Campspot for online reservations. This is a free online web based booking software. There is a \$3.00 customer charge per online reservation with no support costs, set up fees or update fees for the service. Motion was made by Bryan Vidrine and seconded by Daniel Arvie to move forward in gathering more information with Campspot with all the specifics for online reservations. Motion carried.

Workers on Wheels were then discussed, which is an independent service to perform maintenance and/or services for the campground in lieu of camping for free. Legal stated that some sort of release would need to be initiated and to make sure they are properly licensed and insured. More information will be gathered and brought back before the jury.

Mr. Ortego stated that painting of the fence at the entryway of the park is still not complete. This service was included in the bid from Invision when the security gate was installed. The company was contacted; however as of today painting has not been done.
